ADDITIONAL SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure reliable and safe operation of this equipment, please read carefully all the instructions in this user guide, especially the safety information below.

Electrical Safety

- The TV set should only be connected to a main power supply with voltage that matches the label at the rear of the product.
- To prevent overload, do not share the same power supply socket with too many other electronic components.
- Do not place any connecting wires where they may be stepped on or tripped over.
- Do not place heavy items on them, which may damage the leads.
- Hold the main plug, not the wires, when removing from a socket.
- During a thunderstorm, or when not using the television for extended period of time, turn off the power switch on the back of the television.
- Do not allow water or moisture to enter the TV or power adapter. Do NOT use in wet, moist areas, such as bathrooms, steamy kitchens or near swimming pools.

- Pull the plug out immediately, and seek professional help if the main plug or cable is damaged, liquid is spilt onto the set, if accidentally exposed to water or moisture, if anything accidentally penetrates the ventilation slots or if the set does not work normally.
- Do not remove the safety covers. There are no user serviceable parts inside. Trying to service the unit yourself is dangerous and may invalidate the product's warranty. Qualified personnel must only service this apparatus.
- To avoid battery leakage, remove exhausted batteries from the remote control, or when not using for long period.
- Do not break open or throw exhausted batteries on a fire.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix Alkaline,Standard (Carbon-Zinc) or Rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) or (Nickel Metal Hydride) batteries.

Physical Safety

- The ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings with items, such as newspapers, table-cloths, curtains, etc.;

HOW TO HANDLE THE LCD PANEL

- Do not press hard or jolt the LCD panel. It may cause the LCD panel glass to break and injury may occur.
- If the LCD panel is broken, make absolutely sure that you do not touch the liquid in the panel. This may cause skin inflammation If the liquid gets in your mouth, immediately gargle and consult with your doctor. Also, if the liquid gets in your eyes or touches your skin, consult with your doctor after rinsing for at least 15 minutes or longer in clean water.

Possible Adverse Effects on LCD Panel: If a fixed (non-moving) pattern remains on the LCD Panel for long periods of time, the image can become permanently engrained in the LCD Panel and cause subtle but permanent ghost images. This type of damage is NOT COVERED BY YOUR WARRANTY. Never leave your LCD Panel on for long periods of time while it is displaying the following formats or images:

- Fixed Images, such as stock tickers, video game patterns, TV station logos, and websites.
- Special Formats that do not use the entire screen. For example, viewing letterbox style (16:9) media on a normal (4:3) display (black bars at top and bottom of screen); or viewing normal style (4:3) media on a widescreen (16:9) display (black bars on left and right sides of screen).The following symptoms are not signs of malfunction but technical limitation. Therefore we disclaim any responsibility for these symptoms.

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- LCD Panels are manufactured using an extremely high level of precision technology, however sometimes parts of the screen may be missing picture elements or have luminous spots.
- Do not install the LCD Panel near electronic equipment that produces electromagnetic waves. Some equipment placed too near this unit may cause interference.
- Effect on infrared devices – There may be interference while using infrared devices such as infrared cordless headphones.

CONDENSATION

Moisture will form in the operating section of the unit if the unit is brought from cool surroundings into a warm room or if the temperature of the room rises suddenly. When this happens, unit's performance will be impaired. To prevent this, let the unit stand in its new surroundings for about an hour before switching it on, or make sure that the room temperature rises gradually. Condensation may also form during the summer if the unit is exposed to the breeze from an air conditioner. In such cases, change the location of the unit.

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Television Antenna Connection Protection

If an outside antenna or cable system is connected to the TV, be sure the antenna or cable system is grounded to provide some protection against voltage surges and built-up static charges.

Section 810 of the National Electrical Code, ANSI/NFPA NO.70, provides information with respect to proper grounding of the mast and supporting structure, grounding of the lead-in wire to an antenna discharge unit, size of grounding conductors, location of antenna discharge unit, connection to grounding electrodes, and requirements for the grounding electrodes. CONNECT DEVICES TO YOUR TV

Check to ensure that you have selected the right cables for the ports and that they are connected securely (cables and external devices not included). Loose connections can affect your picture and audio quality.



The cables mentioned in this guide is not supplied with your unit.

SETTING UP YOUR TV

1

Place Batteries in Remote

Power your TV remote by inserting the batteries carefully matching (+) and (-) indicated inside the battery compartment.

TIP: Always replace dead batteries with two brand-new batteries from the same manufacturer. Never use damaged batteries.

If your remote gets warm/hot during use, discontinue use and contact a service center.

Plug in and turn on TV

Plug your TV into the wall outlet and press the power button on your remote control.

Follow the on-screen instructions

When your TV powers on, follow the easy on-screen instructions for setup.

Your TV will automatically detect wireless networks in your area, so have your network name and password handy. If you aren't ready to connect to a wireless network you can still use it as a regular TV.

Activate your smart TV

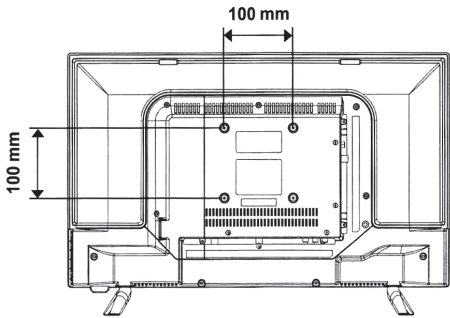
Activate your TV using your computer, smartphone, or tablet to link to a Roku account. You need a Roku account to activate your TV and access entertainment across thousands of streaming channels.

NOTE: ROKU DOESN'T CHARGE FOR ACTIVATION SUPPORT - BEWARE OF SCAMS.

Roku accounts are free and while a valid credit card number is not required to create a Roku account, saving your credit card information makes renting and purchasing entertainment from the Roku Channel Store fast and convenient. Once connected to your account, your TV will automatically update with the latest software, and you can start streaming immediately.

Attach the Wall Mount Bracket (not included)

The TV is provided with mounting holes for a VESA approved wall mounting bracket (Not Supplied). Remove the screws holding the base to the base bracket and lift the base away (do not remove the base mounting brackets). Mount the VESA bracket using 4*M4*10 isometric threaded screws (Not Supplied).



WARNING

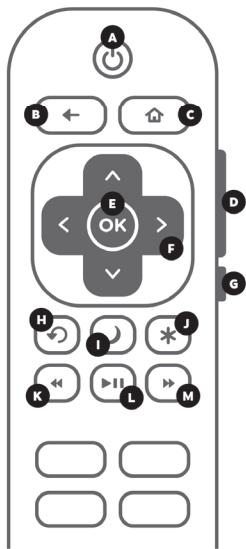
Never place a television set in an unstable location. A television set may fall, causing serious personal injury or death. Many injuries, particularly to children, can be avoided by taking simple precautions such as:

USING YOUR REMOTE

The Roku TV remote should feel right at home in your hand. We designed it to be incredibly intuitive for watching TV and navigating on-screen menus.



- A Power** Turn TV on and off
- B Back** Return to previous screen
- C Home** Return to Roku Home screen
- D Volume** Raise and lower volume
- E OK** Select an option from a menu
- F Navigate** Move up, down, left or right
- G Mute** Mute and restore sound
- H Instant Replay** Replay the last few seconds of streaming video
- I Sleep** Set the sleep timer
- J Options** Access to picture settings, more streaming channel icons and more
- K RWD** Rewind streaming video, scroll left one page at a time
- L Play/Pause** Start or pause playback
- M FWD** Fast forward streaming video, scroll right one page at a time

TIP: The button gives you easy access to picture settings, display options and more. Try it on every screen.

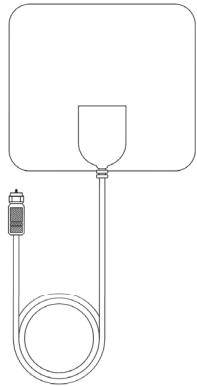
Actual remote includes pre-set channel buttons with channel logos.

The remote control vary depend of model: The buttons on the remote control may have a different name or location than the remote control shows in this manual.

CONNECTING AN ANTENNA

With the built-in tuner you can connect your TV to an antenna and enjoy over-the-air entertainment.

- When the setup wizard is complete select the Antenna/Live TV icon from the home screen.
- Follow the on-screen instructions.
- Whenever you want to watch antenna TV, select the Antenna/Live TV icon.
- Live TV Pause feature: Pause up to 90 minutes of live antenna TV when you connect a 16 GB or larger USB drive to your TV. All data on the USB drive will be deleted prior to use.



UNIVERSAL REMOTE SETUP

If you prefer to use your cable set-top box or satellite receiver remote as a universal remote, please refer to the manual your cable or satellite service provider. It includes instructions on how to program your remote to your TV.

ACCESSIBILITY

How to Enable and Disable Text-to-Speech(TTS) on my Element TV?

Your Element TV has a built-in Audio Guide, which includes Text-to-Speech and Video Description, which assist users to navigate the on-screen menus.

Text-to-Speech, or TTS, is a form of speech synthesis that converts written text into a spoken voice output. This allows visually impaired people to listen to digital content that they are unable to read.

Video Description is audio narration added to a TV or movie soundtrack describing key visual elements that blind or visually impaired viewers might otherwise miss. Such elements include settings, scene changes, speaker identification, clothing, facial expressions, actions, and onscreen text.

Once this Text-to-Speech feature is activated, the Audio Guide will read out text, menu items, and other on-screen items. Once Video Description is activated, Audio Guide will describe key visual elements by audio narration.

Below are the step-by-step instructions to enable or disable this feature:

- Press on your remote to open the main screen.
- Scroll up or down and select Settings.
- Press the right arrow button and select Accessibility.
- Press the right arrow button and select Voice Guide or Video Description.
- Press the right arrow button and select ON to enable or OFF to disable the text-to-speech or Video Description feature.

Tip: If Shortcut is enabled, you can enable or disable the Audio Guide by pressing the **Option** button four times in quick succession.
